By joining us on this "wet season" planting day you'll be helping with the ongoing revegetation of areas along Nemarluk Drive. For anyone not yet familiar with the network of walking tracks and recently planted areas along Nemarluk Drive, please do come along, take a stroll, and have a read of our great interpretive signage.
