Variety, the Children's Charity, NT would like to invite teens to participate in the 2017 Goanna Park National Adventure Camps. There are two camps being held from Saturday, 1 July to Saturday, 15 July 2017 at the Goanna Park National Adventure Camp facility, one hour out of Darwin.

Each year, Variety NT runs the National Adventure Camp for teenagers with mild to moderate special needs from around Australia. As part of the adventure experience, campers sleep outside in large screened tents and participate in various activities such as abseiling, motor bike riding, fish feeding, horse riding and go-kart racing. The Goanna Park Adventure Camp program is designed to assist participants gain self-esteem and confidence, to challenge their comfort zones, develop life skills and promote friendships with other participants with whom they can empathize.

The camp is funded by the Variety office in each State or Territory and includes accommodation, food, entry fees and airfares when applicable.

Safety is paramount and every care will be taken in ensuring that participants have an enjoyable and safe Camp. Qualified instructors, experienced Carers and a Registered Nurse are on-board to oversee all operations and St Johns Ambulance is on call at all times.

Unfortunately, due to the nature of the camps activities and the terrain at Goanna Park we are unable to cater for wheelchairs or other mobility equipment.

Goanna Park 2017 Camper Guideline

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- The Camp is organised for teenagers who are disadvantaged, sick or with a special need. Due to the nature of the camp, teens with behavioural issues may need direct attention and supervision for their safety and the safety of others so please notify Variety upon application so the adequate support can be managed prior to the camp. This is important.
- Ages should be 13 17 years for both boys and girls (as at date of Camp)
- Due to the activities, and to ensure enjoyment by all participants, it is requested that campers have a level of communication that allows comprehension of basic instructions. An average level of gross motor skills is required. Those skills should include the ability to walk unaided.

- All activities are voluntary and there is one or more swimming activities so we do
 recommend that campers can swim, however, alternative programs can be organised if
 advised in advance.
- Boys and girls should be independent in lifestyle and personal skills, such as hygiene and toileting.
- All campers applications are to be accompanied by a letter from a registered health practitioner (children on medication are welcome provided a doctor's letter with medication requirements is sent to the Camp Registered Nurse with registration forms). Enough medication must be supplied with the camper for the duration of the camp including travel time. Medication should be in its original container with dispensing instructions clearly identified or in Webster Packs (preferable). Please provide your child's doctor's name and phone number as requested on the application form. The final decision about the child's suitability to attend camp will be at the discretion of the Camp Coordinator in conjunction with the Registered Nurse.
- Parents must sign the Campers Application Form (which includes the Camper's Declaration and Permission form) before their child can be accepted.
- Parents are not expected to accompany their child on the camp. From past experience, the teenagers attending Camp show much greater personal development and independence in a new environment away from their usual routines, confines or familiar faces. However, applications from parents with genuine and compelling reasons to attend will be considered.

What to Bring on the Camp

What to Bring on the Camp

Please label all clothing with a laundry marker. A laundry bag will be issued to each camper

- 1. Sleeping Bag & Pillow (compulsory)
- 2. Shoes/Trainers/comfortable shoes and thongs/sandals for bedtime and early morning
- 3. Toiletry items
- 4. Mosquito Repellant and Sunscreen ESSENTIAL
- 5. Pocket money if a child is bringing pocket money to purchase souvenirs, we recommend a \$50 limit
- 6. Clothing suitable for outdoor activities and sport.

Note temperatures drop to 16-18 degrees at night so include a pullover/cardigan and warm pyjamas. One pair of jeans or similar will also be required for horse riding. Day temperatures are up to 36C during the Dry Season. It does not normally rain in June/July. Laundry days will be Tuesday and Thursday, so plan clothes required with this in mind. A minimum of 7 sets of underwear are recommended and at least 5x t-shrits and 5 x shortss

- 7. Bathers
- 8. Two (2) x towels 1 for the shower, 1 for the pool
- 9. Hat
- 10. Torch (with new or spare batteries) ESSENTIAL
- 11. Water bottle
- 12. Feminine hygiene products if required to last one week
- 13. MEDICINES and MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS ESSENTIAL
