



Questionnaire Study for Adults with Autism/Asperger's Syndrome and neurotypical controls

Researchers at UNSW Australia and Autism CRC are seeking volunteer research participants to learn about life in adulthood for people with Autism Spectrum Conditions.

Would the research project be a good fit for me?

The study might be a good fit for you if:

- You are an adult over the age of 25 and you have Autism; OR (Please note: If you do not have autism and would like to participate in this study, please also contact us as we are looking for participants to be involved as part of a neurotypical comparison group)
- You are a carer or a family member of an adult over the age of 25 with Autism

What would happen if I took part in the research project?

If you decide to take part you would:

- Complete a questionnaire either online or via a paper copy.
- The questions will be about many aspects of life including mental and physical health, employment and other day occupations, behaviour, emotions, coping, memory, friendships and health service utilisation.
- It might take 2 to 3 hours to finish, but you don't have to do it all at once.
- Complete a second questionnaire about two years later if you want to.

Will I be paid to take part in the research project?

No, you will not be paid. However, you will be making a highly valuable contribution in furthering knowledge and contributing to work which aims to improve the lives of adults with autism
